Slaughter cattle were a little stronger again this week and continue to inch their way back up. Slaughter cows were steady this week. We didn't have as many really good cows on the top end of the market, but what we had sold very steady or even a little stronger compared to last week. The calf market continues it's ways and was a little weaker this week compared to last week's jump in the market. The Hay market is steady, although we aren't getting a lot of really top quality hay to test that top end of the market. There seems to be a lot of medium to lower quality hay on the market at this time. Well, October is here and we're really excited here at TLA for all the great things about to happen this month! We start sales this weekend with our Alternative Animal Sale on October 4-5. The Horse Auctions begin with the Friesian Fall Classic on October 18-19, followed by our regular Driving Horse Auction on October 26th. We will round out the month with our Fall Draft Horse, Carriage and Equipment Auction October 28-November 1. We have a five day schedule this Fall. We are really excited about the quality of horses that are headed to Topeka, Indiana this October. We hope to see you at TLA this Fall. It is definitely where the Auction is!!
