WINTER PARKING, SNOW and SLUSH REMOVAL

ROADS - Parking

The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

Cascade City Code (7-2-2)

limits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City for a period of no longer than two 2 hrs.

SNOW / SLUSH -and MUD REMOVAL

Cascade City Code (5-7-1)

It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.



Are your exterior lights Dark Sky compliant?

It's getting darker earlier. Exterior lighting that is noticeably non-compliant is being identified and we will reach out to you with recommendations to bring exterior lighting on your property back into compliance.



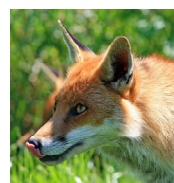

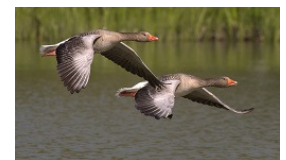

FY 2023/2024 Water/Sewer Base Rate Increases
Water Base Rate \$15.99 to \$16.46 = **up \$0.47**
Sewer Base Rate \$28.07 to \$28.91 = **up \$0.84**
The new rates, effective October 1, 2023, will be reflected on your November bill for October service.

As part of the City of Cascade water system upgrades, new radio read water meters will be installed at all service locations over the next few months.

Your water service will be interrupted for 10-20 minutes while the installation occurs. Public Works staff will do their best to knock on your door and give you a heads up when they are ready to install at your home.

Installation for commercial locations will be performed prior to or after your business hours.
