Coaches Report – Mrs. Desiano spoke about the Winter Concert, the theme is "The Greatest Showman." Girls are being asked to wear black leggings or black shorts, (if shorts are worn then the girls also need to wear fishnet stockings). Red or gold shirts and black jazz shoes will also be required.
