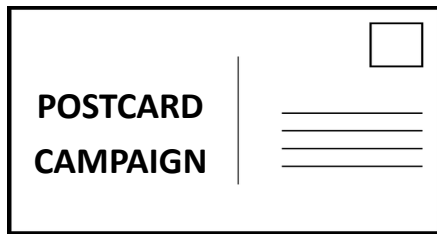

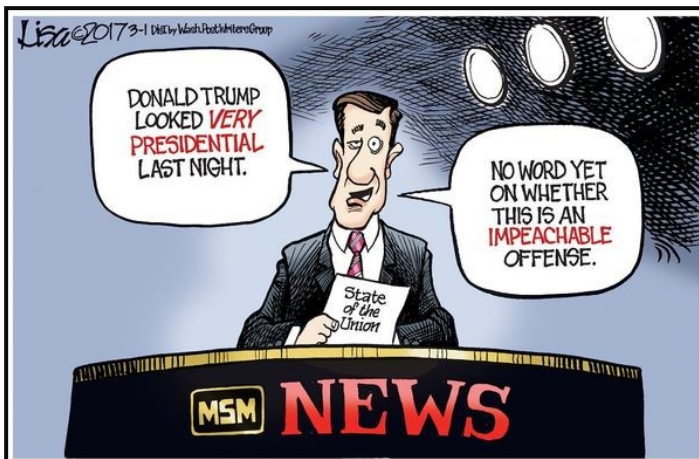
\*\*\*\*\*SAVE THE DATE\*\*\*\*\*

1. Sanctuary State: if you agree that California should not become a sanctuary state for illegal aliens convicted of serious felonies, go to [www.anderson.cssrc.us](http://www.anderson.cssrc.us). Click on 'Sign the Petition. Stop SB 54's Felon release.' Senator Kevin DeLeon (D) admitted publicly that members of his own family were illegal.

According to Ruth Weiss, Election Integrity Project, the LA ROV admitted having 30,000 dead voters on its roles and at least 37,000 voters who voted 2 or more times in the last election.
