Stalls:

NO tie outs allowed or portable pens. Stalls must be purchased. Stalls will be \$65.00 for the weekend. (must be included with call ins)

Trailer/Camper Hook-Ups/Camping:

Reservations must be made through Delaware State Fair Grounds. Information about camping will be updated ASAP. The cost will be \$40.00 per spot to include water and electric. See Delaware State Fair Camping Rules/Regulations.

Admission:

Each contestant will receive 2 wristbands for family. Contestants will be allowed in using their back number. Contestants are able to buy additional wristbands for family for \$5 each for the weekend. (Please request additional with call ins).

Check—In:

Mandatory Contestant Meeting:

Contestant Meeting will be at 5:00 PM sharp in the grandstands on Friday, November 6th. All contestants (all states, all ages) must attend this meeting and be in proper dress code.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are required for EACH day and MUST be paid in cash. Also, entry fees for all events must be paid during check-in.

Rodeo Dress Code for Contestants and Parents:

(All contestants, volunteers/parents working in the arena, anyone in and around the bucking chutes, any helpers, trainers, and those waiting with contestants near the entry gate) 1 person per contestant.

Awards:

Payouts and All Around Awards to be awarded. All payouts will be mailed to state secretaries after the event.

COVID-19 Rules:

There will be a COVID health form and temperature check daily, more information will follow.

Additional Ground Rules:

The following items are required of pet owners visiting the Delaware State Fair, outside the ten days of the fair. If not adhered to, the local authorities and/or SPCA may be contacted:

1. Pets must wear current and valid rabies tag(s) and name tag(s).
2. All domestic pets must be kept on a leash and in the company of their owner.
3. Pets must be kept inside your camping unit unless you are outside; when outside, pets must be kept on a short leash
4. Pets must left inside your camping unit when you are away from your site.
5. Pets may be off your site only when being walked on the road directly to or from designated dog walk areas; designated walk areas shall be any grassy area ONLY.
6. When walking your pet(s), owners must carry a means of cleaning up pet's waste and dispose of waste in receptacle provided.
7. Pets must not disturb other guests. Excessive barking will not be tolerated, and the pet owner will be required to remove the offending pet from the premises.
8. Pit Bulls, Rottweilers, and other attack-prone dog breeds and exotic pets are not permitted at the Delaware State Fair. Please inquire prior to your arrival.
