

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
Ordinance O-2014-02

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES BETWEEN AMELIA VILLAGE AND RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2013, Village Council advertised for bids for a three year contract for the collection of solid waste within the territorial jurisdiction of Amelia Village; and

WHEREAS, only Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. submitted a bid to the aforementioned request for bids; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to enter into a contract with Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. for waste collection services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Village Council hereby directs that the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to sign said contract for waste collection services which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documentation and coordinate all logistics for the implementation of the contract with Rumpke of Ohio, Inc.

SECTION II. Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for said emergency is the immediate need to continue waste collection services within the Village. As such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

Derrick Campbell moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
