Melvin F. Farver, age 75 of Pigeon, (Caseville Township), passed away Sunday, February 16 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon.

Mr. Farver was born in Chandler Township on November 1, 1916, son of the late Clarence and Lucile (Cox) Farver. On February 20, 1938 he married Meta A. Trost at Cross Lutheran Church in Pigeon. He owned Farver Sand & Gravel until 1959, then was employed with Rooney Construction and the Elkton DPW, retiring from the DPW in 1978, after 15 years of service.
