Water Rehabilitation Project & INDOT Project Updates

The Town of Cromwell is almost through the planning portion of the upcoming Water Rehabilitation Project. We are pleased to announce that we received an OCRA Grant in the amount of \$700,000. This grant will allow us to make necessary updates without initiating a substantial rate increase. Thank you to everyone who participated in the surveys and/or wrote letters of support.

Also this year, the Indiana Department of Transportation will be completing a culvert project on State Road 5, near the railroad tracks. The Town of Cromwell is not in charge of this project, but we want to make sure all residents are aware as it may impact travel.

Please be mindful that there will be contractors in and around town going forward with both of these projects. We are excited for the improvements & appreciate your understanding as the work is completed.
