#### What is the Teen Book Review Board?

The County of Los Angeles Public Library is accepting applications for the Teen Book Review Board. This board is made up of 10 Teens (*grades 7-12*) from different areas of the County who will select Young Adult Fiction to review. The Teen Book Review Board will run from October 2016 through June 2017. Each month Board members will each select one book from the library's collection to read and then they will be asked to write a 150-250 word book review of that book. These reviews will be submitted to their Editor/Librarian then, after editing, posted to the Teen page of the library website (www.colapublib.org/teens).
