Thank you for your interest in our school. This letter will hopefully provide you with answers to the questions we are most frequently asked. Please call us anytime or come and visit our classroom.

Classes are held two or three days a week, two hours per day. Courses will be offered evenings (afternoon hours are available during summer as well). You must have six (6) sessions of behind-the-wheel instruction and thirty (30) hours of class time during your course. This means that if you miss a class or a drive lesson, you will need to make it up.

The course cost is \$450.00 and includes: thirty (30) hours of classroom training, six (6) hours of behind the wheel instruction, and one (1) attempt at the Knowledge Test (if the student does not pass after the first attempt they will then be subject to the Knowledge Test fee of \$35).

By way of general information, you can get your learner's permit at age 15 by enrolling in a traffic safety education course through an accredited school. Otherwise, you must be 15 ½ and pass the written test at a drivers training school. Once enrolled in our class, we will electronically notify the Dept of Licensing, and you will then be eligible to get your learner's permit without taking the written test 10 days prior to the start date of the class you enrolled in. When going to the Dept of Licensing to get your permit you will need:

- -Original birth certificate or Passport
- -Social security number
- -Picture I.D. (student ID card)
- -Washington ID # (link on our website to obtain this)
- -\$25 (this is subject to change check with DOL for current fees)

You need to have had your learner's permit for at least six (6) months and be sixteen (16) years old before you can obtain your license. The Department of Licensing requires that you have driven with your parent or guardian for at least fifty (50) hours during the six (6) months prior to getting your license. It is recommended that at least 15 of those hours take place during the driver's training course.

Special Rules for Teen Drivers

When teens get a driver's license, they must follow some special rules and restrictions. These rules are in place to help protect teen drivers from accidents and help them develop and improve skills in the safest way.

If you are under 18, you will be issued an intermediate driver license and must follow these special rules:

- For the first 6 months, you cannot drive with passengers under the age of 20 unless they are members of your immediate family (spouse, child, stepchild, or siblings both by birth and marriage).
- For the next 6 months, you may not carry more than 3 passengers who are under 20 years old who are not members of your immediate family.
- For the first 12 months, you cannot drive between 1 am and 5 am unless you are with a licensed driver age 25 or older. The only exception to this rule is if you drive for agricultural purposes, meaning you transport farm products or supplies under the direction of a farmer (see RCW 46.20.070).

After 1 year of following these rules and driving without a collision or traffic citation, you can drive without limitations to the time of day or the age and number of your passengers.
