“Whoever has two cloaks should share with the person who has none.”

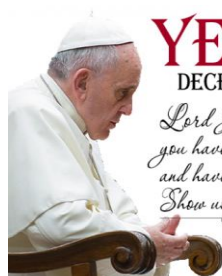

Politicians promise whatever they think will get them elected. Sadly, many do not keep their promises. Imagine a campaign ad that challenged people: “If you have two good suits, share with the person who has none. Share your food with others; stop selling products for more than they are worth to acquire excessive profits; do your part to support yourself and all dependent on you; do not falsely accuse anyone; and be satisfied with your wages,” and adds, “If elected, I will adopt policies to make sure everyone does this.” Have you heard any politician say anything like that? Do you think that person would get elected? Not likely. John and Jesus would have a hard time getting elected in our present culture. As we get close to Christmas, John is telling us that Jesus did not come to be God Incarnate to get elected to public office, but so we could elect to imitate Jesus - like John did.

St. Pius X will remain open every day during the day (December 8, 2015-November 20, 2016) for those who wish to come and pray.

“A Father Who Keeps His Promises” begins Jan. 7

A new monthly study of the book, “A Father Who Keeps His Promises,” by Scott Hahn, is taking place at Mount Saint Joseph Conference and Retreat Center beginning January 7. The book focuses on God’s covenant Love in Scripture. It explains how God patiently reaches out to us — despite our faults and shortcomings — to restore us into relationships with his divine Family. Hahn begins with Adam and Eve and continues down through the generations to the coming of Christ and the birth of the Church.

Other than Jan. 7, which is the first Thursday, the classes will take place on the second Thursday of each month (there is no class in July). The sessions begin at 10:30 a.m. and end after lunch is served at 12:30 p.m. There is a \$10 fee per class. The facilitator is Sister Ann McGrew, OSU.
