The Catacombs of Anubis at North Saqqara have been known since at least the late 19th Century. However, no serious work had been carried out on them before the present project directed by Professor Paul Nicholson.

The galleries have been re-mapped, leading to new interpretations of them, and the number of animals which they might once have considered is very much higher than has previously been thought, numbering - it is thought- in the millions.

This Talk reviews the history of the catacomb and the new work carried out there.

The SSAE was formed in 1992 and is aimed at people in the Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire and south Yorkshire areas with an interest in Ancient Egyptian history and art.
