



### IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE

- You will be required to install an ignition interlock if convicted of DUI
- You will be required to install an ignition interlock if convicted of Reckless or Negligent Driving 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and you have a prior DUI
- You will be required to install an ignition interlock if you do a deferred prosecution

### IGNITION INTERLOCK LICENSE

- You can drive during a license suspension with an ignition interlock license
- The ignition interlock license requires an ignition interlock device, SR 22 insurance and an application
- The application must be submitted to the DOL first and costs \$100

**You Have 20 Days to Save your License**  
**Complete the DOL Driver's Hearing Form Following your Arrest**

## The DOL Hearing

Following your arrest for DUI, Minor DUI, or Physical Control you only have 20 days to request a DOL hearing. A DOL hearing is a formal appeal to a pending license suspension. If you request a DOL hearing your license will not be suspended until or unless you lose the DOL hearing. The DOL hearing is conducted on the telephone by a hearing officer who determines 4 issues:

1. Was there a lawful basis to stop or contact the petitioner (driver)?
2. Was there probable cause to arrest the petitioner?
3. Was the petitioner properly advised of the Implied Consent Warnings
4. Was the breath test, blood test or "refusal" valid?

The hearing can last as little as 5 minutes or as long as one hour. The law enforcement officer may appear at the hearing if the petitioner requests his/her presence (by serving a subpoena). The petitioner does not have to attend the DOL hearing so long as they have counsel (an attorney) who appears on their behalf. Typically the results of the hearing are not known until 2-4 weeks following the hearing.

### Driver License Tips and Information

**CDL**- a DUI will suspend your CDL for 1 year  
**SR 22** – you will need SR 22 insurance for 3 years if suspended  
**Deferred Prosecution** – will save your license (not "refusals")  
**Reinstating Your License (do not drive until ...)**

- Go to DOL office
- Pay reinstatement fee
- Complete alcohol evaluation and ADIS class

### Crimes that Will Suspend Your License

DUI (from 90 days to 4 Years)  
 Minor DUI (90 days)  
 Driving While License Suspended 1<sup>st</sup> Deg (1+ year)  
 Driving While License Suspended 2<sup>nd</sup> Deg (1 year)  
 Hit and Run Attended (1 year)  
 Reckless Driving (30 days)
