I'm off for a few last minutes with my friend from New York. I'll catch up with you next month at Stoneybrook.

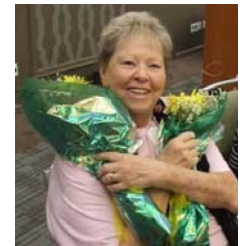

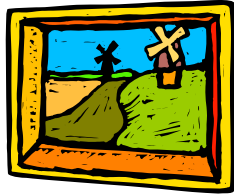


