Leone M. Fritz, 81 of Saginaw and formerly of Unionville and Caro Areas, passed away Tuesday, Oct. 17, at Saginaw General Hospital.

She was born Feb. 20, 1914 in Alberta, Canada. She moved to the Cass City Area at the age of nine with her parents, the late Francis and Buelah (Agar) Kennedy.

She later met Norman Fritz while he was on his milk route. They married Jan. 19, 1936 at the Owendale EUB (now United Methodist) Parsonage.

Mrs. Fritz had been employed at the Clark Canning Company, Caro, and later at Michigan Sugar Co., Caro, and Stokely-Van Camp, Croswell, before retiring in 1978.

She was a former member of the Caro United Methodist Church and Women's Society.
