- 3. I assume the risks of being bitten, scratched, injured, or frightened by cats, kittens, dogs, and puppies in connection with my fostering for PAL. PAL is not liable to me for any injuries, damages, liabilities, losses, judgments, costs, or expenses whatsoever which I might suffer or sustain in connection with the performance of my volunteer foster activities for PAL unless they are the result of PAL's gross negligence or intentional misconduct. I will indemnify, defend, and hold PAL harmless from and against any claims, lawsuits, injuries, damages, losses, costs, or expenses whatsoever sustained by any companion animal or any person in connection with my intentional misconduct or grossly negligent performance of volunteer activities for PAL or my breach of PAL's rules, regulations, policies, and programs.
- 4. Any modification to this agreement must be in writing signed by both parties. This agreement is binding upon me and my respective heirs, successors, assigns, executors, and personal representatives.
