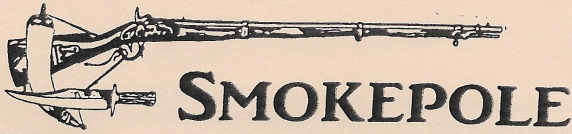

LAST MONTH'S SHOOT: I was there but there were no paper targets to score or shooter list so I have nothing to report on except a brimful pot of stew by John Grimes who also ran the shoot (I got to stir instead of score) so none of us who stayed for potluck had to go away hungry. If I get shoot results for summer I will publish them.

LAST MONTH'S MEETING: After much time spent by President Walt Evens preparing an application to the BLM for a permit for use of the Sharp's Creek site (a process expected to take 6 months and entailing certain restrictions on said use) the club voted to drop that effort in favor of the Curran property. With that decision, plans were firmed up for a trial run camp-out and shoot on the property the following weekend. Details follow!

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

We had our first camp-out at Curran's property near Walterville. It was decided to keep the group small at first with just the members who attended the May General Meeting. Primitive camping was optional. Most opted for more modern tentage. Fire season started on the 1st so it was cook stoves for everyone!

We went up on Friday to clear brush, set up the Privy and whatever work could be done. The clangers couldn't be delivered until Saturday morning. John Grimes brought 10 up from our stash at EEGC. He and Steve Gilmore set them up. Thank you both for that. Even though I've had my surgeries, I still have to be careful what I lift.

Bob and Melody Morrell as well as Lorraine Hayden camped on Friday night. Jim Eikenberry came up the following morning. I had an NRA Instructor course on Sunday. As a result, I really didn't want to set up camp for just one night.

We originally had a site picked out for the targets but the Buffalo decided it would be a perfect spot to spend the morning. We ended up with a small trail walk just north of the camping area. Just before we started, the Buffalo changed their minds and started heading our way. With a little persuasion from Steve's Trade Gun and a few others, they finally headed elsewhere. It's no wonder they almost went extinct. When the shots are fired, they just stand there and say "What was that?"

We kind of paired up to shoot the "Walk". I'm glad because some of the targets just "rang" and I couldn't hear them. As it was a fun shoot I just brought my trade gun.

Afterwards, a few gathered around the Hawk and Archery targets. Member John Eden gave tutelage to Lorraine Hayden. I had pretty much given up due to my wrist and shoulder limitations. Lorraine's bow only has a 25-pound pull. I was able to hit the burlap a couple of times with John's coaching. I thought I had everything and now I am going to have to buy a bow and arrows!

Nobody did any knife or hawk throwing while I was there. I had my knife but couldn't find my hawk. It's my understanding the club has some for use.

It was kind of a relaxed event with no real time constraints. We will be discussing how often we want or can do these outings. This property has a lot of potential. Plans are in the works to set up a "Permanent" Trail Walk. We might be able

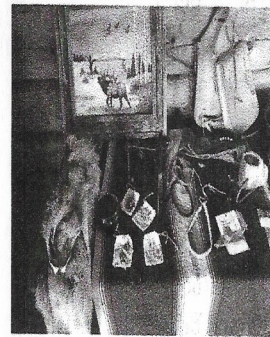
