

<u>Despite Restrictions,</u> <u>Holy Week is Always Special!</u>

Yes, this will be a very different Holy Week but let us not forgot how wonderful it is. I have always loved going to the Cathedral on Tuesday of Holy Week to see my brother priests and people from the different parishes I have been assigned in the past. Sadly, that will not happen for me this year. The Bishop will be there with a bare bones amount of clergy and people. One of the great things that happens at this Mass is our Holy Oils are blessed by the Bishop. The Oil of Chrism (for Baptisms and Confirmation), the Oil of Salvation (for Baptisms and those coming into full communion in the Catholic Church) and the Oil of the Sick (those sick, about to undergo an operation and those who are close to death) will continue to be part of our liturgical year.

One new thing I will add to Holy Week is to provide all of you the opportunity for Confession from Tuesday through Saturday so that you can receive the sacrament before Easter. Here is how the week will unfold:

Confession Times and Places

Tuesday April 7- 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Wednesday April 8- Day of Grace 9 a.m.- Noon at Sacred Heart 2 p.m.- 6p.m. at St. Joseph Holy Thursday- 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Good Friday- 10 a.m. at Sacred Heart

Holy Saturday- 3:30 p.m. at Sacred Heart

I ask that when you come to any of these confession times that if you are able to kneel that you go behind the screen to give your confession. If you are not able to kneel then we can have a face to face confession. Please do not come if you are not feeling well.

As most of you know, the Sunday Mass has been live streamed, and I will continue to do that. Although you cannot attend Palm Sunday Mass, palms will be available for you to pick up at both parishes by 12:30 p.m. We will also be live streaming the Holy Triduum at St. Joseph Parish- the holiest time of the year (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil). We will not have the catechumens come into full communion in the Catholic Church for the Easter Vigil. That will happen hopefully some day during the Easter season. We will also be live streaming Easter Sunday Mass at 11 a.m. at Sacred Heart. I hope we can all be together at Mass sometime in the near future!
