Acts 17:16-31 Psalm 66:8-20 1 Peter 3:13-22 John 14:15-21



### This Week with Your Family


In Psalm 66 we are reminded how God loves and hears us.

BB the Bible Bot loves to see what God has created. He also loves to see what kids like you can create.




