We are beginning to gear up for this year's CROP Walk, which will take place Sunday, October 20, at 2:30pm (registration starts at 1:30pm) beginning at Corpening Plaza. The Lunch and Learn for Team Captains and pastors will be held August 28 at Home Moravian Church (registration from 11:30am, lunch 12:00-1:00pm). Last year we had a total of 1,210 walkers and raised \$83, 930.51 for the three causes, which are our own Sunnyside Ministry, Crisis Control Ministry (a ministry of the churches of Forsyth County), and Church World Service (of which the Moravian Church is one of the 37 member denominations and serve together to meet needs both here in the US and abroad).

We are now seeking to identify Team Captains for local congregations. We are grateful for Bethania's participation in the walk last year with 2 walkers and raising \$778. Please confer with your board regarding identifying someone to lead this effort at Bethania this year and let me know who will serve. Thank you for your efforts on behalf of this important event!
