

HOW TO LOGON TO YOUR NEW GOOGLE ACCOUNT USING YOUR SCHOOL EMAIL



Before you begin, make sure you have received your child's school-issued email account and temporary password.

Sample school-issued email account: **astudent@pauldenschool.com**Sample temporary password: **password1**

Most web browsers will work with your new Google account. However, we recommend using **Google Chrome**. Other browsers (Mozilla/Firefox & Microsoft Edge) should work well. (Note: some users have reported problems with older versions of the Internet Explorer browser).

To download the Chrome web browser, go to: https://www.google.com/chrome/



After you have installed the Chrome web browser (or other preferred browser), go to www.google.com.




Next, go to the upper-right hand corner of your web browser and you should see a blue "Sign-in" button.

Click the "Sign-in" button to proceed.





In the box labeled "Email or phone", type in your child's new school-issued email account. (example: astudent@pauldenschool.com)




Then, click the blue "Next" button.


Now it's time to enter your **TEMPORARY** password. (Note: your temporary password is all lower case – no capital letters)

Your temporary password is: password1






If you are prompted, read the Google welcome screen and click the blue box labeled "Accept".






From this screen, you will create your new password. Type your new password in the box labeled "Create password"... and again in the box below labeled "Confirm password". (Note: passwords must be 8 charters or more)



Click the "Change password" box to proceed.




Congratulations! You now should be logged on to your child's school email and Google account!
