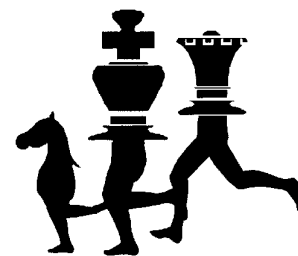

AUGUST CAMP has enrolled students of various chess skill levels

1. Enrollment priority is given to full-day, full week students. Full Day (8:30 to 5 p.m.) Half Day (8:30 to 12:30 or 1 to 5 p.m.) At this point, only students enrolling for two or more full days will be accepted or three or more half days. We will be conducting chess competitions/testing and physical fitness competition/testing that will require consecutive days to complete.
2. Full-Day players bring a bag lunch; a.m./p.m. healthy snacks provided to all. All players should bring their own water bottles - refill water cooler available.
3. Two or more instructors (plus additional coaches/junior leaders) involved so both beginners and experienced players will benefit from these camps.
4. Ages 8 and above recommended; younger students may be accepted if older sibling also enrolled or if they are experienced players who have proven themselves able to take classes.
5. Raw beginners not knowing legal moves or basic concepts such as checkmate must first be evaluated at least two weeks prior to their first camp. The evaluation will also include basic chess teaching materials which should be studied prior to first day of camp. Evaluations are FREE and last about 30 to 45 minutes. 6. Students who have NOT been involved in a Roving ChessNuts school program or class or previous camp (or not having a national chess rating) should also be evaluated so we can better know what help they need in developing their chess skills and make sure they do understand game concepts.
7. Weather permitting each camp day will feature 60 to 110 minutes of sports and running/fitness activities and testing. Students should have appropriate footwear and outdoor wear. appropriate for the day's weather. Please make sure all clothing has child's name marked.
8. All participants must sign and abide by a code of conduct related to sportsmanship, behaviour and chess etiquette. Parents must sign waiver form.
9. All new participants will receive a national Chess'n Math rating, a discount voucher for entry in a scholastic chess tournament and a camp chess souvenir.

Additional notes:

Testing with certificates to be awarded during the week. For Full Week participants there will be both a regular chess competition and a commando chess competition (play a game of chess, then a fitness activity <run, standing jump, ball throw> repeated for several rounds); awards for best in both competitions. All participants will receive a 24-page chess manual/exercise booklet. There will also be a booklet for all participants on fitness and chess ideas for families. Due to both the chess and fitness curriculum planned for the August camps, enrollments for single full or half day will not be accepted - two or more consecutive days must be arranged.



August fees: Full Day \$55 plus GST • Full Five Days: \$235 plus GST • Half-Day: \$35 plus GST • Five Half Days: \$145 plus GST

For August camp: A \$50 deposit is required to reserve a space. Early Bird Prepayment Discount expired on July 10.

Other discounts: 15% Reduction for second sibling from same family • 10% discount on August camp if attended July camp for full week.

Payment can be made by cheque, credit card, debit card or cash. Refund, minus \$15 administrative fee can be requested for cancellations received two weeks prior to start of camp. In case of illness or other reasonable absence, credit can be extended to other camp dates or other Roving ChessNuts programs and classes.
