



Communication Verses

Some suggestions to make this exercise more impactful in your life:

1. Write out each verse, word for word. It will help you concentrate on what you are reading.
2. Pick out one or two verses that have really impacted you and commit to memorize them.
3. Write a verse on a 3x5 card and carry it with you to remind yourself how God says we should communicate to one another.
4. Talk with your spouse or someone in your life who knows you well and ask them if they see you displaying the type of communication listed in the verse. Then ask yourself, “Is this how I want to be known?”
5. Pray the verse back to God. Ask him to forgive you for communicating poorly and seek His help to change; or thank Him for how he has helped you in this area of communication. (Involve God in the process.)
