

BWDs Stipulated Judgment Outreach During 30-day Public Review Process – November 25, 2019

Goals:

- Provide all BWD Ratepayers information/knowledge/support to understand the components of the Proposed Stipulated Judgment documents, at their desired level of detail
- If after understanding the Documents at his/her desired level BWD Ratepayers still feel issues are not adequately addressed in the Stipulation Documents, encourage submittal of a Public Comment.
- Offer help for those desiring to submit a comment to make sure the issue is clearly described and most likely to receive a responsive answer, if requested.
- Inform the Ratepayers about potential Community Impacts.
- Provide process for Ratepayers to feel their comments have been heard

Objectives:

- Make available the Qualified Experts needed to explain the documents/process and respond to questions
- Listen to the Ratepayers and react accordingly, within legal parameters
 - Comments to date: Be Transparent, Publish Comments Received/Responses when Possible, Update FAQ, What are Impacts on Ratepayers, PLUS??
- Opportunities for Spanish speaking residents to receive information and participate in the 30-day process
- Hold meetings at times conducive to encouraging greater attendance/participation
- Hold meetings at the appropriate frequency to encourage understanding of the Documents
- Provide Phone in Opportunity
