ROERS ROARS TO FIRST TOUR TITLE

HESS RETURNS TO WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 3rd TIME

ROERS BECOMES TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION

Max Roers is the GISBT's newest champion. This month, he became the 3rd consecutive first-time winner in the boy's division, following in the footsteps of Ryan Kyllonen at our January event in Muscatine, and Cameron Crowe, who won last month's title in Moline, Illinois.

The champion didn't get to the Winner's Circle without overcoming a few obstacles along the way. Roers found himself in 17th place with just 3 games remaining in qualifying. Then, the right-hander unleashed a furious rally, going from -2 to +125 over his final 3 qualifying games to secure the #7 seed heading into the finals – his first match play finals appearance.

Roers instantly grabbed the lead by firing a 251 in his very first match to go from 7th place to the top of the standings. He traded places with eventual runner-up Billy Hibbard over the next 4 games, but his steady string of 242, 244, 257, 239, 234 and 235 to close out his match play round was enough to secure the victory.

The Maple Grove, Minnesota resident became the first champion to win in his first match play finals appearance since Blake Eddy of Orient, Iowa turned the trick at last season's April Saturday event.

ROERS BECOMES 122nd BOYS CHAMPION

This month's champion became the 9th different boy's champion to hail from Minnesota. The first Minnesotan to claim a GISBT title was Luke Voaklander, of Shorewood, who captured the 2001 Tournament of Champions. Since then, fellow Minnesotans Matt McNiel, Erik Vermilyea, Jason Price, Matt Bellus, Tony Handrahan, Caleb Baker and Ryan Kyllonen have added their name to that list. Only McNiel (12 titles) and Vermilyea (4 titles) have earned multiple GISBT crowns.

Roers became the 122nd boy's champion in the 279-event history of the Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour. For his 16 games, Roers averaged 227.43. He took home the championship plaque, a \$350 scholarship, and earns a permanent place on Champion's Row. Congratulations Max!

4-TIME CHAMP HIBBARD SNAGS RUNNER-UP

Billy Hibbard turned in another impressive performance. The Mukwonago, Wisconsin resident has been one of the GISBT's most consistent shotmakers over the past 4 seasons, racking up 4 wins, 20 match play finals appearances and more than \$4,000 in tour earnings. This month, Hibbard rolled into match play just 41 pins from the lead, and by winning his first 5 matches, he assumed command. He couldn't hold off the stellar charge from Roers, and eventually he settled for runner-up honors, and the accompanying \$200 prize.

EVENT DRAWS 78 ENTRIES

This month's event drew a total of 78 entries (62 boys and 16 girls). Included in this number were 9 players making their GISBT debut. Welcome to all of our new and returning players!

QUALIFYING LEADER SOLONKA FINISHES 3rd

Dakota Solonka, an Indianapolis, Indiana native, was this month's 3rd place performer. Solonka, one of four 2-handers in this month's boys finals, was the sharpest player in qualifying, as he averaged 226.87 for his first 8 games to earn the High Qualifier medal. Appearing in the 8th match play finals of his tour career, he took home a \$175 scholarship for his finish. He was one of 3 past champions appearing in this month's boy's finals.

DIERCKS PLACES 4th

Alex Diercks was this month's 4th place finisher. The lanky right-hander from Cedar Rapids, lowa took home a \$150 for his efforts. Appearing in the 4th match play finals of his career, Diercks used back-to-back games of 278 and 296 late in match play to surge into 4th.

RODENZ 5th IN TOUR DEBUT

Tyler Rodenz was one of 9 players making their tour debut at this month's event, but his results were easily the best of that group as he turned in a 5th place showing; he earned a \$130 scholarship. The right-hander from Kasson, Minnesota, qualified 8th, just 2 pins ahead of 9th, to earn his spot in the finals, and steadily moved into 5th place as the finals progressed.

CROWE CRANKS OUT 6th PLACE FINISH

Cameron Crowe finished 6th at this month's tour stop. The hard-hooking southpaw from Orland Park, Illinois rolled into the event hot off the heels of his victory at last month's event in Moline, Illinois. He continued that momentum by turning another solid day on the lanes, earning a \$120 scholarship for his 6th place finish.

MONNENS TAKES 7th

Jordan Monnens, a 2-handed southpaw from Ham Lake, Minnesota, finished 7th in Cedar Rapids. Monnens was returning to match play for the 2nd time in his promising career; this time out he took home a \$110 scholarship for his performance.

LARSON 8th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

Brock Larson, 19, rounded out this month's boy's match play finals field. The 2-hander from Eldridge, Iowa earned a \$100 scholarship fo his performance. Larson was appearing in the very first match play finals of his promising career; he was one of 3 first-time finalists in this month's boys finals field.

FORDE FIRES PERFECT GAME TO EARN HIGH GAME OUT OF THE MONEY

Tristyn Forde grabbed this month's \$55 high game out of the money scholarship. The talented right-hander from New York City fired the day's only 300 game in his qualifying round. Congratulations, Tristyn!

HESS BACK IN WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 3rd TIME

HESS BACK IN WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR VICTORY # 3

Megan Hess returned to the GISBT Winner's Circle for the 3rd time in her career at this month's event. The right-hander from Granger, Iowa qualified 3rd, and then put on a razor sharp finals display by averaging 216.50 for her 6 games, winning 5 matches while losing just once to outdistance the competition.

Hess steadily built her lead during the finals, eventually pulling away by 158 pins with just 2 matches remaining. However, she stumbled with 163 in game #5, which enabled eventual runner-up Anna Warkel, who tossed a 232 in game #5, to slice that lead to just 59 pins heading into the position round. There, she started fast, and logged an impressive 227-207 victory to put the win under lock and key.

This marked the 10th career match play finals of her career, and with it, she took home the championship plaque, and the first place prize of \$250. For her 14 games, the champ averaged 205.28. Congratulations, Megan!

WARKEL ARRIVES ON SCENE WITH IMPRESSIVE RUNNER-UP FINISH

Anna Warkel enjoyed a breakthrough performance at this month's GISBT event. The high school junior rolled into the event in sharp form, having just won the Iowa State singles championship in record fashion just days earlier. She continued that fine form in her hometown of Cedar Rapids by emerging as the top qualifier by averaging 209.87 for her 8-game qualifying block. Although she was overtaken by the eventual champion, her runner-up finish signaled her arrival as a potential star on the GISBT scene.

The right-hander with the big strike ball was appearing in just her 5th career tour event, with her highest previous finish being a 12th place showing at this season's October stop. This month, she netted a \$175 payday for her runner-up showing.

ROERS PLACES 3rd

Hana Roers, a promising player from Maple Grove, Minnesota was this month's 3rd place finisher. The talented right-hander made her tour debut at November's tour stop in Waterloo, where she finished 7th. This time out, she was in fine form, ultimately finishing in 3rd place; she earned a \$150 scholarship for her efforts.

MOORE TAKES 4th

Rachel Moore continued to show her prowess as one of the tour's most talented young stars. The Keokuk, lowa native rolled into her 5th match play finals, and would take home the \$125 award by finishing 4th at this month's tour event.

SUNDSTROM 5th IN CAREER BEST SHOWING

Ashley Sundstrom was this month's 5th place performer, and that represented the best finish of her tour career. The right-hander from Cedar Rapids, Iowa took home a \$110 paycheck for her days work. Sundstrom was returning to the finals for the 2nd time in her career, but the first since she finished 6th at the Waterloo event in September 2017.

FOX 6th IN FIRST MATCH PLAY FINALS

Sarah Fox made just her 2nd GISBT appearance this month, and it resulted in a 6th place finish. The Elmwood Park, Illinois native earned a \$100 scholarship for her finish.

Brynna Madison took home this month's \$55 scholarship for having the highest game out of the money. The slender right-hander from Lincoln, Nebraska rolled a 255 during her qualifying block to earn the award.
