THE CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION AS LAID DOWN BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY ARE AS FOLLOWS:-

- Children who are "looked after" by a local authority or adopted children who were previously "looked after".
- ✓ Children assessed by the local authority as being in need according to the terms of the Children Act or as having special educational needs likely to result in an Education Health Care Plan under the Education Act, where the assessment concludes that their needs would be best met by that school.
- ✓ Children who have a brother or sister attending the school when the places are allocated or who has attended the school within the last three years provided the family has not moved further from the school in the meanwhile.
- Children who, when places are allocated, have a brother or sister at Moss Hall Infant or Moss Hall Junior School.
- ✓ Children who live in the London Borough of Barnet, giving priority on a geographical basis but taking account of the proximity and location of the child's home in relation to the school of preference and to all other community schools in the area that offer nursery provision.
- ✓ Any remaining places to be offered to children living outside the Borough, on a geographical basis giving priority to those living closest to the school when distance is measured in a straight line.
- ✓ If there are insufficient places available to offer all pupils in a particular category, the remaining categories in the list are applied in order.
