GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel we experience Jesus as the Good Shepherd who cares for His flock. St. Francis de Sales reminds us that we too must be good shepherds who tend our flock:


Some say that shepherds represent all those who wish to become holy: but if each of us is a shepherd, who are our sheep? They are our desires, feelings and emotions. We must keep watch over this spiritual flock. Jesus teaches us how to govern and rule over our desires, feelings and emotions, our flock that we must shepherd.

Like a shepherd who cares for his flock, our Good Shepherd gathers us all around Himself in order to make us His own. He wants us to manage our lives in light of the Will of God, rather than our own willful desires. In Jesus, we learn how to govern our flock and direct our desires, feelings and emotions in a way that leads to spiritual health.

What can be more pleasing to Our Divine Shepherd than to bring to Him the lamb of our love? Love is the first desire of the human spirit. True love is accomplished when we live according to the inspirations and promptings that God places in us.

Our God is the God of the human heart. Our hearts thirst for God. We have a natural inclination to know and love God. No other love can satisfy us as the infinite goodness of God, from whom we gain infinite nourishment.

St. Augustine said: "Love God, then do what you will." When all of our loves flow out of God's love, then we can say that we truly love God. How happy we will be if we remain in the presence of Our Good Shepherd and faithfully imitate Him by following His example! We will then serve God as God wills and be a good shepherd to ourselves as well as others.



REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

En el Evangelio de hoy experimentamos a Jesús como el Buen Pastor que cuida de su rebaño. San Francisco de Sales nos recuerda que también nosotros debemos ser buenos pastores que cuidan nuestro rebaño:

Algunos dicen que los pastores representan a todos aquellos que desean llegar a ser santos: pero si cada uno de nosotros es un pastor, ¿quién son nuestras ovejas? Son nuestros deseos, sentimientos y emociones. Debemos velar por este rebaño espiritual. Jesús nos enseña a gobernar y gobernar sobre nuestros deseos, sentimientos y emociones, nuestro rebaño que debemos pastorear.

Como un pastor que cuida de su rebaño, nuestro Buen Pastor nos reúne a todos en torno suyo para hacernos suyos. Él quiere que manejemos nuestras vidas a la luz de la Voluntad de Dios, en lugar de nuestros propios deseos voluntariosos. En Jesús, aprendemos cómo gobernar nuestro rebaño y dirigir nuestros deseos, sentimientos y emociones de una manera que conduzca a la salud espiritual.



The P. Holley Burch Council of the Knights of Columbus is offering a scholarship to a high school senior who is enrolling in a continuous education institution upon graduation. The applicant must be a member of St. Francis De Sales Catholic Church and have participated in volunteer work for the church, and their community or school. In the event that there are no eligible high school applicants, students currently enrolled in an institute of higher learning may also be eligible, provided they have not previously received this scholarship. Awarding of the scholarship is contingent upon proof of enrollment in an institute of higher learning; examples include a tuition statement, class schedule, or letter from the registrar. Applications may be submitted to any brother knight in good standing, mailed to the church, or dropped off at the parish office.

The application deadline is June 1st.

Proof of enrollment must be provided to K of C prior to July 31st.

The scholarship will be awarded the 1st Sunday in August at the 10:30 Mass.
