Old Business:

Fire Department: Respiration Protection program is underway. Fit testing policy motions are underway and need be completed ASAP.

Covid-19 Task Force: Task Force has met with the boat lines to identify key questions and priorities for planning ahead to the summer season. Wharf guidelines and boat line protocol have been revised and updated.

Updated Monhegan Travel Guidelines have been posted to the Monhegan Plantation website.

The issue of boat line demand and passenger capacity under COVID-19 related guidelines has been raised and the boat lines are working to specify capacity limits for each of their boats.

CBAC: Motion to appoint Andrew Dalrymple to CBAC is tabled until next assessors meeting to further evaluate the opportunity.

New Business:

Condemnation Order: Review of condemnation order document: the question was raised regarding the definition of the broadband line's 25 foot corridor. Referring to the interpretation of the legal council writing the condemnation order, as well as those intimately involved in the broadband project, the consensus was reached that the condemnation order does not take any land, but that the 25 foot corridor definition provides space for flexibility during installation. The condemnation order does not take any land or real estate, only the right to cross over, on, through, or under, property where the water utility line already exists.

Motion to accept condemnation order language as presented passes

Motion to accept property owner inventory passes with amendment to include all property owners serviced by the water lines so to ensure that all properties who wish to receive broadband service can do so without added burden of acquiring additional easements in the future.

Local Health Officer Appointment: Jes Stevens is interim health officer.

Municipal Officer Positions Needed: First Assessor, Third Assessor, Local Health Officer. Jim Buccheri expressed interest in third assessor or Local Health Officer. Job descriptions and relevant information will be sent to Jim.

Touchless Hand Sanitizer Units: Jes Stevens has found a resource through UMaine to be able to acquire around 50 units. The Board of Assessors is in support of pursuing this opportunity further.
