THE TEAM

Team work



Team work is everything in dragon boat racing. Synchronicity is more important than strength. A perfectly synchronized team will almost always beat a stronger, but less coordinated team. As an experience, dragon boat racing is rich in learning opportunities for any group. It brings together diverse players all of different abilities and strength to achieve a common goal, offers corporate teams and groups a unique opportunity to explore group dynamics and increase productivity and effectiveness.

The Team

A dragon boat team generally consists of 20 paddlers (you may also wish to have several alternates) as well as a drummer at the bow. It is guided by a steersperson at the stern (a steersperson and a drummer will be provided for your team). Teams combine power and rhythm to achieve maximum acceleration and speed over a specified distance. Our races are recreational and many of our paddlers are trying dragon boat racing for the first time. Two (2) practices for each team will be provided in the weeks prior to the races so you will have a chance to get your team ready to go.

Community crews are expected to participate in **TWO** practice times which will be scheduled when registration is received by the club.

ADULT TEAM WAIVER

Waiver of Liability Release, Indemnification & Hold Harmless Covenant

In consideration of my receiving permission to participate in the Belleville Dragon Boat Festival in support of Community Development Council Quinte, as well as join in the practice sessions and to enter the premises and waterways supervised or in any way controlled by Community Development Council Quinte and the Belleville Dragon Boat Club (collectively the "Organizers"), do hereby forever RELEASE any and all liability, discharge and agree to hold harmless and indemnify the Organizers and each of their respective directors, members, trustees, representatives, officers, sponsors, volunteers and employees against any and all causes of action arising out of or related to any such loss, damage, or injury resulting from negligence, breach of trust, breach of fiduciary duty, or any reason or cause.

I also agree to and discharge immediately every obligation or claim by any injury or damage caused to me or my property that shall be made by me, assigned or apportioned against the Organizers and their respective directors, members, trustees, representatives, officers, sponsors, volunteers and employees on their request.

I am duly aware of the risk and hazards inherent in the sport of dragon boat racing, knowing conditions may be hazardous and dangerous, that obstructions may exist and that high winds, may cause rough water. As such, I hereby voluntarily assume all risks of loss, damage or injury including death, that may be sustained by me or any of my property upon entering the premises used for the purpose of and while engaged in the Belleville Dragon Boat Festival in support of Community Development Council Quinte and any practice sessions.

In consideration for my participation in the Belleville Dragon Boat Festival in support of Community Development Council Quinte, I grant its representatives, employees, photographers and the media the right and permission to publish, copyright and use photographs of me and my property, with or without my name, and to reproduce the photographs through any medium for illustration, promotion, advertising web content or other purposes.

This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario. Further, this agreement shall be binding on my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and legal representative, in the event of my death or incapacity.
