If you or your Unit would like to donate to her project, we will be presenting checks to her at the receptions. Please let me know if you will have a donation so that I can recognize you at the reception. All checks should be made out to the ALA Foundation and earmarked for the National President's Veterans Project Fund. She is advocating for Female Veterans and the hardships that they endure. Female veterans are more likely to commit suicide than men. Some female veterans are sexually assaulted during their years in the military. If the female veteran is homeless and she has children, she is less likely to go to a shelter for fear of her children being taken away from her. I hope we have a lot of checks to present to her.

I will be traveling to Washington, D.C. along with Gloria Fochtmann – Haygood, Judy Daughtry and Vickie Thrower- Mills on February 24th to storm the hill with our American Legion Family, where we will be visiting with our Senators and Congressmembers to advocate for our veterans. We will be telling our "WHY." We will be sharing our numerous hours and our many dollars spent. I know that they will be impressed with our work and commitment to our veterans. Please keep us in your prayers for safe travel and for receiving ears to hear.

Membership – We need to continue to work membership. We are losing too many Auxiliary members every year for one reason or another. We are going to start a Revitalization team. We will be setting up a Revitalization Day in each of the three divisions.


I would like to share with you 5 ways to welcome new members:

- 1. Don't wait Make sure that your new member receives some form of communication from your Unit as soon as her membership application is submitted. Don't let them wonder if their membership means anything to the Unit.
- 2. Make sure that they have the information they need. They have joined so now what? Pass out new member packets. Be sure that the new member gets a Unit Handbook. Give out a member roster book.
- 3. Personalize it Find unique ways to tell a new member you are thankful that they have joined. This could be a handwritten thank you note, a phone call from another member, tagging them on social media. Little touches will let them know you are there to support them and that their membership matters.
- 4. Provide peer support Membership offers a unique opportunity to talk to other people who face the same challenges and opportunities that you do. Consider a membership welcoming committee made up of mentors, who will be willing to reach out to new members to see how they can help them become active and involved members.
- 5. Don't go cold Remember, to the new member, the first year of membership is unfamiliar territory, so make sure that you continue to reach out to them even though you have newer members.

If we will practice this, it will help us to retain members and have more involved members. If we make our new members feel welcomed - ultimately, they will become long time members.

I hope to see you all very soon. Remember to let "Your voice be heard for our veterans!"



- 1-199 students in the junior class may send one delegate.
- 200-599 students in the junior class may send two delegates.
- 600 or more students in the junior class may send three delegates.
