BOTH Charlemagne and I were considered shy and thus got to see her fish pond. Naturally we felt that was the best thing we could have since that playground equipment looked sort of dangerous to us.

Today we begin yet another chapter. I truly wish all the children a good year at school with many, many happy memories and friends.
