First Lesson Jeremiah 8:18-22 18 My joy is gone; grief is upon me; my heart is sick within me.19 Behold, the cry of the daughter of my people from the length and breadth of the land: "Is the LORD not in Zion? Is her King not in her?" "Why have they provoked me to anger with their carved images and with their foreign idols?"20 "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved."21 For the wound of the daughter of my people is my heart wounded; I mourn, and dismay has

taken hold on me.<u>22</u> Is there no balm in Gilead? Is there no physician there? Why then has the health of the daughter of my people not been restored?

<u>Second Lesson</u> 1 Peter 1:3-9 <u>3</u> Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,<u>4</u> to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,<u>5</u> who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.<u>6</u> In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials,<u>7</u> so that the tested genuineness of your faith--more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire--may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.<u>8</u> Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory,<u>9</u> obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.
