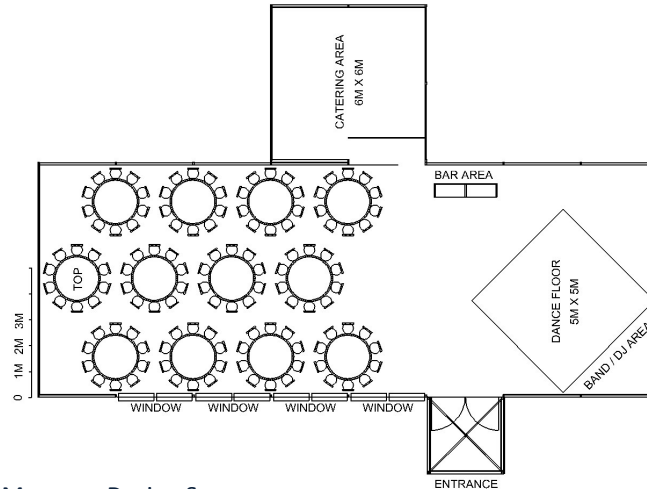




Case Study for a Classic Country style marquee with 120 Guests

Our clients' wish list:

The bride and groom were looking for a simple, classic wedding marquee, with touches of elegance. They also wanted a bright and airy feel with windows that could open, allowing their guests to enjoy their surrounding gardens. Our clients preferred to hold the drinks reception away from the marquee, thus giving each element its own identity and saving the main marquee as a surprise for their guests.



Marquee Design Summary:

We used a Chinese hat style porch for the guest's entrance, with the main marquee large enough to accommodate the reception if bad weather changed the plans. Dining and dance floor areas were provided for 120 guests, with the catering marquee positioned to the side. The interior was finished in ivory pleated lining, new champagne carpet on underlay, and a parquet dance floor. The couple chose lime wash Camelot chairs with ivory seat pads, 5ft6in round tables allowed 10 guests per table, trestle were also supplied for the catering. We provided overhead pins pot and wall up lighters. The couple decided to use in-house toilets and the electrical power was supplied by the house. The total cost was £4,500.00 including VAT.

The venue:

At our first on-site meeting with the bride and groom we discussed a couple of possible areas in the garden. With the overall brief in mind we opted to place the reception area for drinks and canapes on the lawn to the front of the house to greet guests as they arrived. The main marquee for dining and dancing was sited in the rear garden, on level site behind the house, which was more suitable for a marquee without hard flooring. The views of the garden and house on this site also allowed for the maximum use of clear windows, which could be drawn back.
