

Pastor's Paragraphs. . .

13 Uncomfortable Questions

I recently was given a devotional written by another pastor that had some wonderful & challenging insights. He claimed that 60 million (60,000,000) Americans who say they are Christians *never* attend worship or participate in their church. Going to church doesn't bring salvation or make one a Christian, and I don't want to be legalistic about worship attendance, but I don't believe it is possible to be a Christian without being part of a church, including its worship and ministry.

The article continued with a series of probing questions, related to the question of why people don't come to worship:

- Are you so strong that you do not need God or the strength and support of God's people?
- Are you that good that you do not need to hear, on a weekly basis, the promises of God's forgiveness and love?
- Are you so busy that you cannot fit the worship of God into your schedule, yet expect God and God's people to fit your schedule when needed?
- Are you so wise that you do not need to be confronted with the wisdom of God's holy Word?
- Are you that bitter about something, maybe even something that occurred years ago, that you cannot let go of your bitterness and honor God by your presence in worship?
- Are you that lazy that you cannot get up and out on Sunday morning to have your life renewed by God's Holy Spirit?
- Are you so sorrowful that you cannot enter God's sanctuary where peace is offered, faith is shared, and hope is proclaimed?

The article then asked a second series of questions to help define "faithful attendance at worship:

- If your car starts one out of four times, do you consider it faithful?
- If the paperboy skips Monday's and Thursday's editions, would they be missed?
- If you fail to come to work two or three times every month, would your boss call you faithful?
- If your refrigerator quits for a day now and then, do you excuse it and say, "Oh well, it works most of the time"?
- If your water heater greets you with cold water two or three mornings a week would it be considered faithful?
- If you miss a couple of mortgage payments in a year's time, would your mortgage company say, "Oh well, ten out of twelve payments is good enough"?

Friends, we are in the middle of what is often the slowest time of the year – summer. Worship attendance & giving often go down during the summer months. I invite you to build the energy and passion we have here at Puckety, and strengthen the Body of Christ by inviting your friends, family, former members, neighbors, and anyone else you can think of to join us for worship. I challenge you to show your love for Christ by "continuing to meet together as some are in the habit of doing, and let us encourage one another – all the more as you see the Day approaching" (Hebrews 10:25). See ya Sunday at church!

The Sustain-Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP) study aims to help older adults with **overweight or obesity and pre-diabetes**.

We will study how two long-term weight programs may help you improve your health, physical function, and risk factors for Type 2 diabetes. You may be eligible to join if:

- you HAVE pre-diabetes (but not diagnosed diabetes)
- you are 60 years of age and older
- you are overweight or obese
- you want to lose weight and become more physically active (and your doctor gives the OK)

A wonderful tribute for our retired Pastor, Gary Close, from Reverend Ken Foust:

Gary Close Memorial Minute-Redstone Presbytery-May 21, 2019

The prophet Isaiah writes:

"How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, 'Your God reigns!'" (Isa. 52:7)

I never saw Gary Close in his bare feet, but I can tell you without hesitation that he had beautiful feet. For 2 generations of ordained pastoral ministry Gary brought the good news of life and salvation found in our God through Jesus Christ our Lord to the good folks of Puckety and the 3 other congregations he pastored. Through carefully researched and well-delivered sermons Gary presented Jesus Christ as the Way, the Truth, and the Life. In assuming various leadership roles in our presbytery, including moderator and stated clerk, Gary displayed the heart of a servant, leading as Christ has led. Just as Jesus loved being with people, so did Gary, giving his time and attention to anyone and everyone. Beautiful feet, indeed.

His family remembers Gary as one who loved people, even to the point of never speaking badly of others. They were in the best position to see him apart from being a pastor. They remember a man of integrity, of being the same person as husband and father as he was as a pastor. Many pastors speak of making their family a priority. Gary actually lived it out, never sacrificing his family on the altar of professional responsibilities. They remember a man who smiled a lot, even while enduring the pain of 12 broken ribs. From what they shared with me, they knew of his love and care for them and how important they were to him.

I remember Gary as a wonderful colleague. Serving churches in the same small town we could have been competitors, but we weren't, thanks largely to Gary. We collaborated in ministry. Our churches joined together in building a cabin at Pine Springs Camp and for many mission and stewardship programs. We even did a TV commercial together. I found Gary to be both smart and wise, well-disciplined but not rigid, and full of faith and hope and love. He was always there for me as well as many colleagues of Presbyterian and other denominational stripes.

Gary ended his worship services with this benediction that he attributed to Richard Halverson:

"As you leave this place remember this...you go nowhere by accident. Wherever you go, God is sending you. Wherever you are, God has put you there. God has a purpose in your being where you are. Jesus Christ, who indwells you, has something He wants to accomplish in you, and through you, where you are. Believe this, and go in the love, and in the grace, and in the indwelling power of the Holy Spirit."

We, the members and friends of Redstone Presbytery, thank God for the life and ministry of the Rev. Gary Close. We thank God for his place in the Church of Jesus Christ, Eternal and Triumphant. And we thank God for his beautiful feet.
