**WASTEWATER CONNECTION PROCESS**

Dear Landowner(s):

With the installation of the North 43 Lagoon Commission Gunn Regional Sanitary System, there are important mandatory requirements that all landowners must be aware of prior to having your sewage pumping system connected to the North 43 Lagoon Force Main. Please note, it is the responsibility of each individual property owner to contract a qualified company to install the approved pumping system in the approved holding tanks.

Steps to connect your sewage pumping system to the North 43 Force Main:

1. You must first obtain and submit the proper Development Permit(s) from your Municipality (if required):
  - a. Lac Ste. Anne County – Joe D. – 780-785-3411
  - b. Summer Village of Castle Island – Shelley Marsh, 780-418-8348
  - c. Summer Village of Yellowstone – Diane Burtnick, Development Officer –  
Phone: 780-284-0410
2. Once Permits have been approved by your Municipality, the installation of the North 43 Force Main approved pumping system can progress. A credible contractor must be hired to install the pumping system, this is the responsibility of the landowner. Contractors in the area include:
  - a. Joe Duplessie Office – 780-785-3411
  - b. Joe Duplessie Cell – 780-284-3270
3. All proper Safety Code Permits must be secured from approved safety code inspection agencies in the County or Summer Villages. Once the proper permits have been secured, proceed with installation of the pumping system according to Provincial approved practices. Accredited Safety Code Agencies are:
  - a. Lac Ste. Anne County – Joe Duplessie, 780- 785-3411
  - b. Summer Village of Castle Island – Shelley Marsh, 780-418-8348
  - c. Summer Village of Yellowstone – Superior Safety Codes - Phone: 780-489-4777 or 1-866-999-4777
4. Once the installation of your pumping system has been completed, and inspected by one of the approved inspection groups, please have your inspection reports and Municipal Wastewater Application submitted to the applicable municipality.
5. The North 43 Lagoon Commission, or their representative, will schedule a time to turn on the sewage service connection on your property. This is done by opening the curb cock which is owned by the North 43 Lagoon Commission. Contact:
