## Full Face Mask Diver Specialty

### Who should take this course?

The Full Face Mask Diver specialty course familiarizes diver with the skills, knowledge, planning, techniques, problem and hazards and enjoyment of diving with a full face mask (FFM).

The Full Face Mask Diver Specialty course is intended to serve as a safe, *supervised* introduction to diving within the limits of recreational scuba diving. This course introduces dives to the use of underwater communications. A Full Face Mask Diver certification is a great asset to the PADI Public Safety Diver course.

### What will you learn?

You'll learn how to take care of your FFM. During two dives, in addition to a confined water dive, you'll practice:

- Donning, Removing, clearing of a FFM.
- Equalization of a FFM.
- Dive emergency procedures when using a FFM.
- Underwater communications techniques.

### Prerequisite

If you're at least 12 years old and certified as a PADI (Junior) Open Water Diver or higher, you can enroll in the Full Face Mask course.

Start by contacting Dive Adventures to enroll in the course.

### Equipment Requirements

Clearly a full face mask is necessary along with your basic scuba equipment. Your PADI Instructor or local dive center staff will explain other gear or equipment options you may need to dive comfortably with your FFM. Communications is optional, but is recommended. A snorkel is optional, but recommended, your will need a regular scuba mask.

## Duration

Short classroom session

One Confined Water (pool) session

Two Open Water dives (course can be completed in one day).
