With a change in polarity in the lower chamber of
Congress next year, federal gun regulators are already
getting letters from Republicans over gun control issues.

U.S. Rep. Jim Jordan, an Ohio Republican set to move
into the chair position of the House Judiciary Committee
when the new Congress is seated next January, fired off
a frank letter this week to Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,
Firearms and Explosives Director Steve Dettelbach
letting him know that changes will be likely. Noting that
his office and others have made several requests to ATF
for more information on controversial new rulemaking
initiatives that have fallen on deaf ears, Jordan raised the
prospect of compliance might not be voluntary.

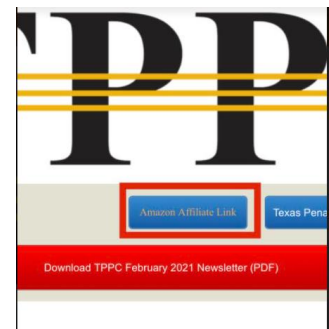
"If these requests remain outstanding at the beginning of
the 118th Congress, the Committee may be forced to
resort to compulsory process to obtain the documents,"
said Jordan in his Nov. 28 letter. "In addition, to advance
our oversight, we may require prompt testimony from
ATF employees. We expect your unfettered cooperation
in arranging for the Committee to receive testimony from
ATF employees."

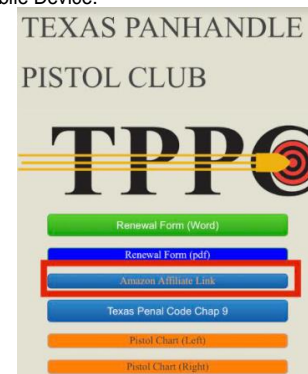

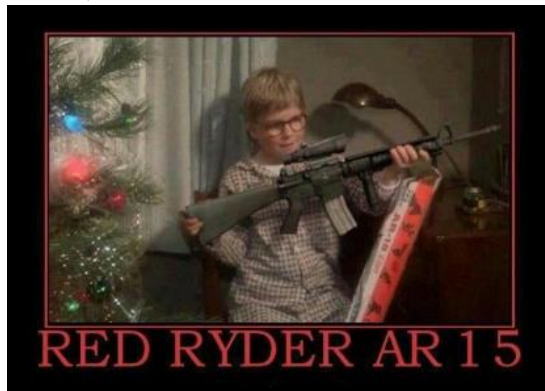

Within hours of haranguing the country on the need to enact restrictive gun control, President Biden let one of the most notorious international arms dealers out of jail.

Early Thursday morning, Biden triumphantly announced his offices had secured the release of Phoenix Mercury basketball player Brittney Griner, 32, from a Russian labor camp where she was serving a nine-year prison term on drug charges.

Something of an international man of mystery, it seems Bout's life is shrouded in lore and conflicting stories. What is known is that he was a former Soviet-era military officer and likely intelligence agent who, upon the collapse of the Warsaw Pact, was able to parley huge stockpiles of arms ranging from AK47s to helicopter gunships into a lucrative business, selling and delivering weapons to just about every African or Balkan civil war across the 1990s and early 2000s

Noted gun rights advocate Alan Gottlieb of the Second Amendment Foundation summed it up, telling Guns.com, "Biden is fine with arming the enemies of freedom while disarming the people who fight for firearms freedom. He should be impeached for violating our constitutional Second Amendment rights."

[Black Friday Week Saw 711,372 Checks for Retail Gun Sales](#) Posted on Guns.Com, by CHRIS EGER

U.S.A. —(Guns.com) — On November 29, 2022 (click on link above to read the entire article) "Black Friday" week gun sales, long one of the high points in the year, were brisk, with last Friday set to enter the list of "Top 10" busiest days in history.

The trade group for the firearms industry, the National Shooting Sports Foundation, released on Monday that the FBI's National Instant Criminal Background Checks System completed 711,372 background checks for firearms at retail locations last week including 192,749 checks on Black Friday alone. This represents a modest 2.1 percent bump over last year's Black Friday figures and will add Nov. 25, 2022, to the list of NICS's "Top 10 busiest days" since the system was established in 1998.

The trade group pointed out that background checks for firearm purchases were already trending to make 2022 the third strongest year on record, coming off the hyperactive years of 2020 and 2021.
