#### Minutes from the October 6th and November 2nd, 2011

The GSSN met at the American Legon Hall in Henderson NV on Wednesday, Oct. 5. 2011 at 6:30 PM.

Pres. Ian Thaler called the meeting to order and led in pledging allegiance to the flag. He welcomed all to the meeting (48 signed in & there were two visitors). Fred Zajac made a motion to accept the minutes of the Sept. 7, 2011 meeting as published in the newsletter; Jim Hansen seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous in favor of the motion and it was approved. Dara Thaler then gave the Treasurer's Report—Fred made a motion to accept the report as read & Jim H. also seconded the motion. It was also unanimously approved. Ian acknowledged those who went to the Sept. 10-11 outing (which coincided with the Coyote Melon Festival) & thanked all who attended and helped out. Doug Parker said that two new members signed up at the GSSN booth. Ian also thanked Jim Hansen for his egg-cracking expertise & Jim likewise thanked Ian for providing not only food but also all his input in making the weekend an enjoyable one.

Next the discussion focused on downloading info and John Bronstein said that a website exists -- <a href="www.minediggins.com/VOTE!html">www.minediggins.com/VOTE!html</a>! - that provides a good resource since Geo- communicator is not up to date. He said it pretty user-friendly. Larry Clay then made a motion to open discussion on a previously tabled amendment to abolish term limits. A discussion then ensued with several members expressing their viewpoints (both pro and con). The ensuing vote was 35 in favor of the motion; 10 opposed; and two abstaining. The motion carried and term limits were thereby abolished.

Next Fred handled nominations for 2012. Jim Hansen nominated Ian for President. There were no further nominations for this office. Ian agreed to accept nomination. Next Ian nominated John Roberts for Vice President. There were no further nominations for VP & John agreed to accept nomination. Dara then nominated Dolores Gee for Secretary. There were no further nominations & Dolores Gee agreed to accept the nomination. Ian then nominated Steve Christenson for Membership Officer. Steve was not present. Fred reminded all that additional nominations can be made at the November meeting, prior to the vote at the December 7th meeting.

Fred then asked for volunteers to help out at the Griffiths School (Oct. 26, 2011 from 9-11:30 AM) at their annual event and asked anyone interested to contact him. He welcomed all to the meeting; there were three visitors & 51 signed in. Dara gave the Treasurer's Report & Fred Zajac made a motion to accept her report as read; Morris Seguin seconded the motion.
