-  A proposed change to the bylaws will be voted on at the July meeting. A full copy of the bylaws is on the [KCoCC](#) website. It is on the "ABOUT" page and on that page will be found right under our vision in the orange box that says "Bylaws". Here is the paragraph as it currently reads (on Page 6, Article IV, Section 4.2, Executive Committee, Membership) "Membership: The Executive Committee may consist of five (5) members including the Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, Immediate Past-Chair, and one (1) voting Member-at- Large elected from the Coalition." **This is the proposed language:** Membership: The Executive Committee shall consist of four (4) elected members including the Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, and one (1) voting Member-at- Large elected from the

Coalition and two (2) ex-officio members, Immediate Past Chair and the Day-to-Day Supervisor of the Coordinator. **Please read it over and be prepared to vote at the July meeting on July 15.** This bylaw change can also be found on the [KCoCC](#) website - "Proposed bylaw Change".
