



Motorama 2022

April 29th – May 1st









4 COD Corvettes were shown at Motorama 2022 at the International Centre. Carl, Brian, Julian and Ken displayed their cars and the display was excellent. Brian won first in his class and Ken won runner up in same class...they both collected thousands of \$\$\$...but not here...congrats from COD. The race cars are not COD members...yet. The late news is that Julian also won a runner up award...congrats.









2022 C-8 Corvette Convertible models account for 48% of all models.



We've been a fan of the C8 Corvette Hardtop models since they were first introduced, and it appears that many Corvette enthusiasts value the ability to lower or raise the roof on demand almost as much as those who prefer the looks of the Coupe as it offers a view of the LT2 "Jewel under glass." With its exotic car looks and no tradeoffs for storage space, the Convertible model has roared back to 48% of all Corvettes produced in 2022. That's a 6% increase over the 2021 convertible model penetration and it's still quite possible for the convertible to actually be the top-selling model in the near future.

Having a <u>C8 Corvette</u> sitting in your driveway could make you the "envy" of your neighborhood.

Now the 2021 Stingray is literally the "eNVy" of the automotive industry, having won the latest InMoment eNVy Award as the Best Premium Sports Car for the second year in a row.

The InMoment eNVy Awards are given to the top vehicles in several market segments, based on customer response ratings of their vehicles' ability to deliver on the five most common reasons for purchase: comfort, quality, performance, safety, and ownership cost. InMoment collected feedback in its New Vehicle Customer Study from 290,000 domestic and 50,000 Canadian owners.





This morning at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, IMS President J. Douglas Boles and Chevrolet Motorsports representative Todd Christensen announced the official pace car of the 2022 Indianapolis 500 will be the 2023 Corvette Z06 wearing a special 70th Anniversary livery. This is the 19th time that Corvette has been chosen to lead the pack of IndvCar racers to the Green Flag and the start of "The Greatest Spectacle in Racing." The announcement was made on the famous "Yard of Bricks" which constitutes the start/finish line at the historic racing venue. Driving the 70th Anniversary Edition Corvette Z06 Pace Car is former IndvCar Series driver and team owner Sarah Fisher. who still holds the record as the fastest woman in Indianapolis 500 history. Fisher has nine starts in the Indy 500 between 2000 and 2010 which is also a record for female drivers.



CTMP Announces Chevrolet Partnership for Canada's Biggest Sports Car Race



May 11, 2022 - Canadian Tire Motorsport Park (CTMP) today announced a new partnership with Chevrolet Canada that will see the automotive brand become the title sponsor of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship race at the legendary road course on July 1-3.

"It's an exciting time for Chevrolet Canada as we present the Chevrolet Grand Prix at CTMP this summer. Corvette fans are enthusiasts with a deep appreciation for our race program, so it's a natural fit for us to be the title sponsor for the IMSA race," said Michael MacPhee, Chevrolet Canada Brand Director. "For the first time in Canada, the Chevrolet Grand Prix will debut the C8.R and we can't wait to cheer the team on!"

Now called the Chevrolet Grand Prix, the event is the only stop in Canada on the world class IMSA WeatherTech Championship calendar, and the first since the event was cancelled in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The series features closed-wheel prototypes and GT Sports Cars, which include world renowned events on such iconic tracks as Daytona, Sebring, Watkins Glen and Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta.

CTMP also has a special connection to Chevrolet and the Corvette brand, with track co-owner Ron Fellows being a former Corvette Racing driver, having achieved numerous wins and championships for the team. Fellows also continues to represent the Corvette brand as an ambassador and through the Ron Fellows Performance Driving School.

"We're all very excited to have IMSA returning to our circuit after a multi-year hiatus," Fellows said. "Having the support of Chevrolet and GM Canada makes it even more special. I think I speak for all our fans too when I say we can't wait to see the teams and drivers of IMSA return to CTMP."

In 2022, the Corvette Racing team continues their title hunt in the GTD Pro class with the No. 3 and 4 cars driven primarily by Antonio Garcia, Jordan Taylor, Tommy Milner, and Nick Tandy.







Corvettes of Durham Cruise Etiquette

The following are some of the rules of etiquette and tips that are practiced for all cruises and outings:

- 1. Bring a walkie talkie with you if you have one.
- 2. Always start with a full tank of gas.
- 3. Attend 'drivers meeting' immediately prior to starting cruise. You will get information on which walkie talkie channel to use as well detailed info on the cruise.
- 4. Keep a safe distance from the vehicle in front without leaving large gaps.
- 5. Be mindful of your driving so that you are not kicking back stones/gravel, etc.
- 6. No passing of other Vettes.
- 7. Keep the car behind you in sight at all times. If the car behind you gets caught at a red light or stop sign or if you can no longer see the car behind, pull over so that we can regroup when possible. The exception to this may be when travelling through a city with a lot of stop lights/signs. In this case, refer to your map, proceed on and regroup when convenient and safe to do so.
- 8. If the car behind you pulls over to the side of the road, you should also pull over as a sign to those ahead of you that there is a problem.
- 9. When stopping, do not stop on the road pull to side for safety.
- 10. When changing lanes or pulling back onto the road, the rear car should pull out to 'block' so that our Corvettes ahead can get back onto the road easier.
- 11. If possible, have the cell phone number of the cruise organizers so that contact them if necessary. You might also want to provide your cell number to them prior to starting the cruise.

The above are suggestions to help make cruising less stressful and safer for everyone;

however it is most important to keep the 'rules of the road' in mind at all times.


