### A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES OF THE CERTIFIED WATER PERSON

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
LATAH, SPOKANE COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

There is hereby created the position of Certified Water Person for the TOWN OF  
LATAH and the duties and qualifications of such a position shall be as established by the  
Resolution of the Latah Town Council.

Section 1.

The Certified Water Person must have the basic knowledge necessary for the operation of  
the Town Water System. They shall:

1. Check the Town Pumping Station every working day
2. Flush fire hydrants periodically and replace hydrants as necessary.
3. The Public Works Supervisor shall maintain the water distribution system of the  
Town; repairing leakage, installing new services to residences and businesses as  
required and any other repairs as necessary.
4. Maintain inventory of water supplies and parts and replace when necessary. Keep  
pump house and adjacent area clean and orderly. Notify each household 24 hours  
in advance by mail or by phone in the event that it becomes necessary to shut off  
water system.

Section 2.

The Certified Water Person will be under the direct supervision of the Mayor and shall  
perform duties and responsibilities as directed. The wage will be the set by the council.

Section 3.

All resolutions and ordinances and parts of resolutions and ordinances in conflict  
wherewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4.

PASSED by the Town Council of the Town of Latah this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 2016.



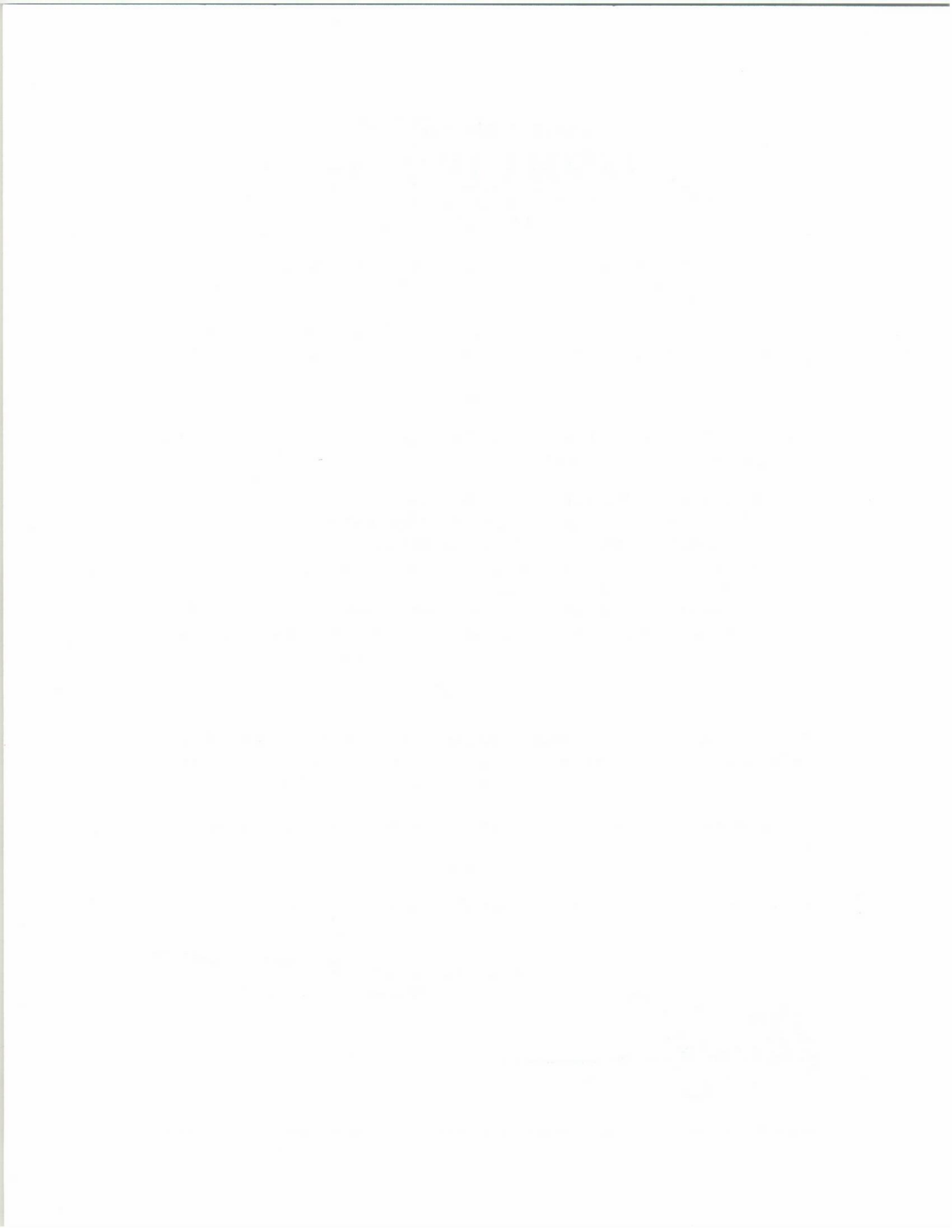


