

## 2022-23 Advocacy Agenda

The **Mission** of the Colorado Rural Schools Alliance is to advocate on rural issues and increase awareness of the unique strengths and challenges in Colorado's rural schools and communities.

## **Guiding Principles**

The Rural Alliance Board is committed to ensuring adequate and equitable access to quality education for all students in rural Colorado and has identified the following priorities for the 2022-23 school year:

- 1. **Full Funding**: Schools should be fully funded and not forced to compete for grants to fund critical programs/positions.
- 2. **Flexibility**: Many/most state mandates are designed for larger urban and suburban systems. Rural districts should have flexibility to implement state priorities in a manner suited to their specific contexts with guidance and support from CDE.
- 3. **Accountability**: The State's accountability system should provide an accurate picture of Rural districts and timely and meaningful data for educators and parents.

## **2023 Legislative Priorities**

- The Rural Alliance supports continuation of Rural funding unless or until the school finance formula is revised in a way that ensures equitable and adequate funding for rural schools.
- The Rural Alliance will work to secure additional, sustained revenues for the BEST program and participate in the reconsideration of grant criteria and review processes.
- The Rural Alliance supports universal preschool and will advocate to ensure that rural schools have sufficient time and resources to implement the new systems in a manner that will benefit their communities.
- The Rural Alliance supports increased funding for special education students and programs to support our severe needs students.
- The Rural Alliance supports revisions to the at-risk factor in the school finance funding formula to include monetary and non-monetary measures and ensure consideration of rural specific needs and concerns.

- The Rural Alliance supports legislation creating a task force to consider and recommend changes to the current state-wide accountability system.
- The Rural Alliance opposes any new or revised reporting requirements without due consideration as to the accuracy of the underlying data in light of the intended purpose.
- The Rural Alliance supports legislation to eliminate frivolous claims against school boards for technical violations of Open Meetings Laws.
