

**Daniel 10:1-3 KJV** - [1] *In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; and the thing was true, but the time appointed was long: and he understood the thing, and had understanding of the vision. 2] In those days I Daniel was mourning three full weeks. 3] I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.*

**2 Corinthians 7:1 KJV** - [1] *Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.*

**1 John 2:15-18 KJV** - [15] *Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16] For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17] And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. 18] Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.*

- ❖ Because flesh and blood shall NOT inherit the kingdom of God, the Spirit said the Church had become to carnal to inhabit the kingdom, so God in his mercy is giving the church one more chance to prepare to meet our God.

**Acts 2:44,46 KJV** - [44] *And all that believed were together, and had all things common; 46] And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,*

- ❖ There are two great spiritual dynamics that the scriptures prophecy will be happening concurrently in these last days:

- 1: A great falling away
- 2: A great outpouring of the Holy Spirit

**2 Thessalonians 2:1-3 KJV** - [1] *Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him, 2] That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. 3] Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;*

## **II: A Great Outpouring of the Spirit**

**Acts 2:17-18,21 KJV** - *[17] And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: 18] And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: 21] And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.*

- ❖ Will you be a part of the great falling away, or will you be the recipient of the great outpouring? Your commitment to personal consecration will determine which of those two spiritual experiences you will be a part of. The great falling away or the Great outpouring.

### **November = month of great REVELATIONS**

**Ephesians 1:17-18 KJV** - *[17] That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: [18] The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,*

### **December = month of great RESTORATION.**

**Isaiah 57:18-19 KJV** - *[18] I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners. 19] I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith the Lord; and I will heal him.*

**Daniel 10:2-3 KJV** - *[2] In those days I Daniel was mourning three full weeks. 3] I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.*

**7 things you must do if you want God to reveal himself and restore you during this fast:**

**1: Decide that you want RAW GOD more than anything or anyone else.**

**Psalms 63:1-2,8 KJV** - *[1] O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is; 2] To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary. 8] My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.*

## **2: Launch out into the deep.**

**Luke 5:4-5 KJV** - [4] *Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught. 5] And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.*

**I: You are in the right place, but you are in the wrong position.**

**II: You are too close to the shore to retrieve more out of the spirit. You will need to move BEYOND your comfort zone.**

**III: This is not a season of generalities it is a season of specificity.**

## **3: Make a promise to yourself to prioritize your soul from this day forward.**

**Matthew 16:26 KJV** -[26] *For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?*

**4: Write down why it is important for you to go on this fast: Be specific about what you want out of the fast, and read those objectives to yourself every day.**

**Habakkuk 2:2-3 KJV** - [2] *And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. 3] For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.*

## **5: Eliminate all unnecessary distractions: (this would include things AND PEOPLE)**

**Proverbs 4:25-26 KJV** - [25] *Let thine eyes look right on, and let thine eyelids look straight before thee. [26] Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established.*

## **6: Utilize the power of a pattern**

A: Prayer  
B: Word  
C: Worship

**7: Take it one day at a time. And enjoy the journey.**

**Matthew 6:11 KJV - [11]** *Give us this day our daily bread.*
