My Brother and Sister Eagles, I hope and pray all of you are doing well. Nearly everyone has troubles this year because of the pandemic. Most of us are accustomed to having troubles occasionally. Some have more that others. All people on some level have troubles. An

old preacher friend of mine used to say "Jim, on every level there is a new devil." This is true. The poor have troubles, the rich have troubles, , the famous have troubles, we have nearly universal troubles. What can we do about it?

A portion of Psalm 23 states "He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters." This Psalm is about a shepherd, and to understand the peace a shepherd brings, you have to first understand sheep. It is almost impossible for sheep to relax and lie down unless four basic requirements are met. It is significant that, to be at rest, there must be a definate sense of freedom from fear, tension, aggravations and hunger. A flock that is restless, discontented, always agitated and disturbed never does well. The same is true of people. We live in a most uncertain life. Any hour can bring disaster, danger and distress from unknown quarters. Life is full of hazards. No one can tell what new trouble a day will produce. We can live either in a sense of anxiety, fear and forboding or in a sense of quiet rest. Which is it? As I have grown older my faith makes all the difference in the world as to whether I flee and remain fearful or stay and weather the storm, I choose the latter and I am sure many of my brother veterans understand this very well. In the midst of misfortunes, the shepherd is there. There is no substitute for the keen awareness that our shepherd is nearby. 
