Lake Mohawk Tennis Club Rules, 2017

Priorities Applicable to All 4 Courts

- 1. Tournaments
- 2. Weekly Club Events (after 5:30pm, see Calendar)

Priorities for Use of Tennis Courts 1 & 2

- 1. Doubles tennis (play changes on the hour if doubles waiting)
- 2. Singles tennis (play changes on the hour if players waiting)
- 3. No Pro teaching permitted on these courts

Priorities for Use of Tennis Court 3

- 1. Pro teaching use within agreed weekday time windows
- Doubles tennis (play changes on the hour if doubles waiting)
- 3. Singles tennis (play changes on the hour if players waiting)

Additional Priorities for All Courts

- On Saturdays, Sundays or holidays and after 5.30 pm Monday-Friday, ADULTS shall have priority for on-the-hour court change on any court on which JUNIORS are playing or for which only JUNIORS are waiting
- 2. Ladder matches: If a club ladder is implemented, ladder matches have no priority when taking a court but must always be allowed to finish

Priorities for Teaching/Pickleball Court 4 Use

- 1. Pro teaching use within agreed weekday time windows
- 2. Pickleball
- 3. Tennis
- 4. Ball machine
- 5. Backboard
- 6. Pro teaching use outside of agreed weekday time windows

Teaching/Pickleball Court operating rules -

- A. Tennis net stays up!
- B. Two pickleball players move the pickleball net to the side (against the fence) when done during day play & under wooden windscreen after last play at night. <u>One</u> person trying to move the net will damage it!
- C. Store paddles & balls in the yellow milk crate in the shed

Junior Members

Minimum age to be at the Club without an adult is 14 years old.

Guests

Each Club member may bring guests as often as desired, within these limits:

- You may bring up to 3 guests at one time, provided you and your guests utilize only one court.
- Residents of Lake Mohawk may be a guest no more than ONE time during a calendar year.
- No guest may play at the club more than TWO times a month regardless of whose guest they are. It is your responsibility to inform your guest of this. *If they want to play more often, encourage them to join our club!*

You and your guests must sign in prior to play. You are responsible for paying \$10/guest/visit. The Treasurer will notify you of your balance at the end of each month and prompt payment is expected. (Pros have different payment rules when teaching.)

Any member who is found violating this or any other provision will be dealt with in accordance with the adopted by-laws of The Lake Mohawk Tennis Club.

Your house guests will not be subject to guest play provisions, IF you get prior permission from a Club Officer. You must accompany your house guest at the club.

Other Rules -

- 1. Appropriate attire is expected. Tennis shoes must be worn at all times; no black-soled tennis shoes are allowed. Shirts must be kept on at all times.
- 2. Each Club member is responsible for keeping the club tidy. Tell a Club Officer if anything requires repair or replacement.
- 3. No food is allowed on the courts.
- 4. Take your alcohol home with you, as we have underage members.
- 5. Evening pickleball the last players store the nets, balls & paddles.
- 6. The last person leaving must turn off all lights and fans, and lock all the doors.
