

BLS CPR Instructor Course

The Oakes Ambulance will be conducting a BLS Instructor course this fall for those interested in becoming a BLS CPR Instructor.

Here are the steps to becoming a BLS Instructor:

- 1. Fully complete a BLS Instructor Course Application form.
- 2. Be accepted by the Oakes Ambulance Community Training Center (CTC) before enrolling in the course.
- 3. Must have a current BLS Provider CPR card and be proficient in the skills of CPR and AED.
- 4. Successfully complete the online BLS Instructor Essentials Course (before completing in-person course).
- 5. Attend an online Zoom session that will review the expectations of the BLS Instructor and the in-person course.
- 6. Successfully complete the in-person training session that will be held in October 2024 (date TBD among students).
- 7. Be monitored by CTC Faculty teaching first course within 6 months.
- 8. Complete registration on the AHA Instructor Network (Atlas).

The course fee is \$300.00 and includes the necessary BLS instructor manual, instructional time, course monitoring, and completion card. The course fee does not include the BLS Instructor Essentials Course (\$41.20).
