ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINEES

- Teachers are educators who teach grades PK-12
- Nominees must be teachers with a minimum of 3 years of teaching experience and must be currently teaching in an Arizona school
- Nominees must be a registered Republican
- Additionally, the teacher should possess and demonstrate consistently:
 - The ability to create a love of learning in students of all abilities and backgrounds.
 - High expectations for all students.
 - A strong sense of values, integrity, and professional ethics.
 - The ability to learn and experiment with new ideas in order to expand his or her professional knowledge base.
 - Knowledge of subject and curriculum content, of student growth and development.
 - Clear understanding of his or her beliefs and practices.
 - Strong communication skills.
 - Energy, enthusiasm, a positive attitude, and depend ability.
 - Commitment to community service and the values of the Republican Party.
