ABSOLUTELY NO CARRY IN FOOD OR DRINKS

<u>Rules</u>

- 1. Eight men or women on the court at one time with at least two of the opposite gender on the court. Example: 6 men and 2 women, or 6 women and 2 men
- 2. Must have waiver signed to play. Players must be 18 years of age or older.
- 3. Rules of regular volleyball will be the same-including rotation of players.
- 4. In the event of an injury, the referee will stop the game, and a substitution can be made.
- 5. Head referee has the right to stop the game or the clock at their discretion.
- 6. THIS IS A DOUBLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT.
- The tournament will consist of double elimination tournament. All games will use rally scoring to 18. Best out of 3 games.
- 8. Shoes must be worn (and be duct taped) on at all times.
- 9. The decisions of the referee are final.
- 10. 1 PERSON FROM EACH TEAM MUST BE A LINE JUDGE FOR THE GAME IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE ONE THEY JUST PLAYED.
- 11. MUST BE ON TIME OR YOU WILL FORFEIT GAME.

Official Mud Volleyball Rules

- 1. All Tournament Director's decisions are final. No protests are allowed.
- 2. Maximum of eight players on the court at one time during a game. Two of the players must be of the opposite gender and on the court at all times. Team rosters limited to ten players
- 3. Players may only play on one team throughout the tournament. The Tournament Director in the event of injuries, etc., may make exceptions. All players must sign a waiver before playing!
- 4. Shoes are mandatory!
- 5. The tournament will consist of double elimination tournament. All games will use rally scoring to 18. Best out of 3 games.
- 6. Teams will provide a referee and scorekeeper for each match as assigned by the Tournament Director.
- 7. Blocking or attacking a serve is not allowed. First violation by a team in a game will be a warning resulting in a replay. Subsequent violations will result in a point being awarded to the serving team.
- 8. All substitutions must be made into the serving position. Substitutes will leave the game from the front right position. Substitutes will enter into the back right position just prior to serving. All players do NOT have to substitute OUT.
- 9. Players will rotate in a clock-wise direction before each serve, including after the first side out in a game.
- 10. Players must keep proper relative position before each serve.
- 11. Only front row players may attack or block the ball when it is above the height of the net.
- 12. All net violations will be called.
- 13. All Jewelry (watches, necklaces, bracelets, etc.) should be removed.
- 14. If the ball hits a pole or its support cables, it is "OUT". "Let Serves" are NOT allowed. If the ball hits the net or the net cables on a serve, it is "OUT". On a return of serve and thereafter, if the ball hits the net or the net cables it is still "IN PLAY".
- 15. Any method may be used to serve the ball, as long as the ball is obviously hit and not thrown.
- 16. Serves will be made from the back right with server standing in mud. If, in the referee's judgement the server is too far out of position, the serve will be replayed.
- 17. Players may not enter another court during, before, or after an attempt to play the ball. Players can play, but not attack, serve or spike the ball from outside the court.
- 18. The score keeper should call out the score before each serve. The referee will motion for serve. The score keeper should assist the referee in looking for net violations and other faults.
- 19. Players may not reach across the net to attack a ball. Players may reach across the net to block a ball, provided that attacking team does not have a play on the ball or has used their allowed three team hits.
- 20. Each team is allowed two 30 second timeouts per a game.
- 21. Maximum of three team hits per side. A female does NOT have to touch the ball. A block does NOT count as a hit.
- 22. The ball may be played by any part of the body, as long as it is not held or thrown. Obvious carries or lifts should be called.
- 23. Incidental contact under the net is not a fault. Players may cross under the net as long as they do not interfere with players on the opposing team. The opposing player does not have to be making a play on the ball for there to be interference.
- 24. Receive of serve is handled in the same manner as any first ball over the net. Overhead / open hand serve receive is allowed.
- 25. NO CARRY IN ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.
