There are currently the standard signs on some Town of Lincoln roads in Stone Lake such as Potawatomi Trail, Jaeger Rd, and Bug Lake Rd. We'd like to replace those and we'd like to add signs on Billy Daniels Ln, Youngs Lane, Young Eagles Ln, and Devils Lake Ln.
