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# AFC/NFC Divisional Forecasts

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Saturday, January 16th

**NFC Divisional: L.A. Rams at Green Bay. 4:35pm ET on FOX.**

Lean UNDER 45.5 and Green Bay -6.5. GREEN BAY 26 L.A. Rams 18. The Rams come in off a dominant defensive performance against the Seahawks last week. They held Seattle to just 11 first downs and 2 of 14 on 3rd Down. QB Jared Goff didn't get the start, but replaced an injured John Wolford and was serviceable throwing for 155 yards while RB Cam Akers had 176 scrimmage yards. It is notable that the Rams are +139 ypg on the road this season and traditionally have been a good road team under head coach Sean McVay with a 22-11 straight up record and a 4-0 ATS mark as a 3-point or more road underdog. On the other side, Green Bay comes in well-rested after the bye. Remarkably, it's the first time in 10 years, that the Packers have clinched the No. 1 seed in the NFC. QB Aaron Rodgers had one of his best seasons ever with a 48-to-5 TD-to-INT ratio and will likely be the MVP. To no surprise, the Packers were dominant at home outscoring their opponents by 12 ppg (+98 ypg). Note Rams games are on a 11-3 run to the UNDER and last week's 50-point total vs Seattle was a bit misleading. We also question how effective Rams QB Goff can be coming off surgery especially in cold temperatures as he only has a 5-7 TD-to-INT ratio in his career with temps 40 degrees or below. We lean with the UNDER and also Green Bay. However, we prefer to take the Packers in a 6-point teaser down to -0.5.

**AFC Divisional: Baltimore at Buffalo. 8:15pm ET on NBC.**

Lean Baltimore (+2.5), it's a 1★ at +3. Baltimore 25 BUFFALO 24. Last week both teams got "monkeys off their backs". Buffalo got their first playoff win since 1995 and Baltimore QB Lamar Jackson got his first playoff win. The Bills were led by QB Josh Allen in their close win over the Colts last Saturday. Allen had 324 passing yards, 54 rushing yards and 3 total TD's. However, it was the first time in 9 games that the Bills didn't cover the spread. Speaking of covering the spread, the Ravens have covered in 7 straight games after out-scoring the Titans 20-3 down the stretch. QB Jackson became the 2nd QB ever to have 100-plus rushing yards and a TD in a playoff game. The Ravens have been good historically on the road under head coach John Harbaugh as they have covered 11 of their last 14 road games and Harbaugh has the most career coach playoff road wins in NFL history. The last time the Bills lost a game was when they faced a dual-threat QB in Kyle Murray. Right now, Jackson is better than Murray and the Ravens have the better defense. We lean Baltimore here but prefer to tease them up to +8.5 through "key" numbers of 3 and 7.

Sunday, January 17th

**AFC Divisional: Cleveland at Kansas City. 3:05pm ET on CBS.**

Lean Cleveland (+10). KANSAS CITY 33 Cleveland 25. We were knew we were in big trouble last week with our Pittsburgh selection on the very first play of the game when Cleveland got a fumble return TD on a horrific snap. The Browns raced out to a stunning 28-0 1Q lead and then hung-on due to a +5 TO margin. Remarkably, a Browns team that had practiced only 1 time in two weeks, didn't have their head coach or 4 key starters pulled off their first playoff road win since 1969! Head coach Stefanski should return here and QB Baker Mayfield is red-hot with a 14-1 ratio. In fact, Mayfield has only thrown one pick since October 25th! Despite their NFL-best 14-2 record, the Chiefs have left a lot to be desired this season. They haven't cleanly covered a game since November 1st! That's a 0-7-1 ATS run, despite a 7-1 straight up record in those games. Each of those 7 wins came by 6 points or less and now they're laying double-digits here! Their starters have been off each of the last two weeks which could create some rust here. We lean with Cleveland who is perfectly capable of playing keep away from KC QB Mahomes with their two RB's Nick Chubb and Kareem Hunt.

**NFC Divisional: Tampa Bay at New Orleans. 6:40pm ET on FOX.**

1★ New Orleans (-3 -115). NEW ORLEANS 29 Tampa Bay 22. Tampa got 507 yards and 31 points last week vs a solid Washington defense but they didn't cover the 10-point spread (line moved from -8 to -10 when Washington QB Alex Smith was ruled out). QB Tom Brady now has a 14-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in his last 5 games. Meanwhile, the Saints dominated the Bears much worse than the 21-9 final (Bears scored a TD on final play of game). The Saints had a 38:59-21:02 TOP edge and held the Bears to 49 rushing yards and without a single 3rd down conversion until very late in the 4Q. The whole "it's tough to beat a team 3 times in one season" narrative is in full-force here but we're not buying it. The reality is the Saints won by 11 in the opener (led 24-7 at one point) and by 35 on the road (38-3) in the two prior match-ups. They are the far superior team. Tampa is 0-5 ATS vs teams that have a Top 10 defense in DVOA, an advanced analytic rating. They failed to cover those games by 11.7 ppg. New Orleans is No. 2 in defensive rating according to DVOA and the Saints are No. 1 overall in that metric (offense, defense, ST's). That includes a stretch where they were missing QB Brees and 3 of their top 4 WR's. New Orleans isn't suffering another playoff heart-break here.
